## **3 on 3 Basketball Tournament**

### ***Rules and Regulations***

Our goal is to provide a quality event that is enjoyable for all participants.

The tournament format will be double elimination. All teams will play at least 2 games. Prizes will be awarded to the winning teams in each division.

- Each team will consist of at least (3) players, maximum (4)
- All baskets and foul shots count as (1) point.
- One free throw on shooting fouls and each team foul over four. No foul shot award if the basket is made during a shooting foul, however, the foul will count towards total team fouls.
- One free throw and the ball on technical fouls.
- Possession alternates. At each change of possession the ball must go back past the foul line (extended). A basket scored without taking the ball back past the foul line will not count, but will not result in loss of possession.
- First possession will be determined by a coin toss.
- After each basket, jump ball, out of bounds, etc. the defensive team must check the ball. After the ball is checked the team with the ball may shoot or bring it forward by dribbling. A “pass in” is not required.
- All games will have a 10-minute running time limit. The clock will only be stopped for injuries. The team leading after the time limit expires wins the game.
- In the event of a tie, we will play (1) sudden death with a 2-minute time limit. The first team to score wins the game. A coin toss will be used to determine which team gains possession. If the game is still tied at the end of sudden death, we will shoot alternate free throws to determine the winner. First basket wins. A coin toss will determine which team shoots first.

#### Scoring

For 3rd through 5th grade divisions, games will be played to 5 points.

For 6th and 7th grade divisions, games will be played to 7 points.

For 8th grade divisions and older, games will be played to 11 points.
